PARKING REGULATIONS DURING WINTER MONTHS:

In order to facilitate the speedy and safe removal of snow from city streets, it is unlawful for the owner or driver of any vehicle to park, cause to be parked or allowed to be parked, said vehicle upon any city street or right-of way of the city street at any time during day or night hours, each year from December 1st through March 1st, of the following year.

“Vehicle” shall be defined to include, but not limited to, automobiles, trucks, trailers, mobile homes, travel trailers, boats, motorcycles, buses, snowmobiles, and other transportation vehicles, whether for the transportation for humans, animals, or freight of any kind.

Violation of this ordinance is a parking infraction. Each day that said vehicle is permitted to continue will be considered a separate offense and/or after twenty-four (24) hours, the vehicle will be towed to a public garage and stored at the owner's expense.
