

### **Upcoming Work Activities**

Work is currently ongoing in both Segment 1, 10300 South to Salem Canal Road, and Segment 2, SR-198 to 10300 South.

### Segment 1, 10300 South to Salem Canal Road:

- Now that the weather is improving, crews will soon begin the process of bringing in dirt to serve as the bottom layer of the new road. This activity should be complete in early May.
- Crews continue to work on the box culvert located near Salem Canal Road and will be intermittently pouring the concrete walls through mid-May. This culvert is 10 feet tall, 150 feet long, and 14 feet wide! When the project is complete, this culvert will allow users of the Salem Canal Trail to cross underneath Loafer Mountain Parkway safely, and without interrupting the flow of traffic.



## **Segment 2, SR-198 to 10300 South:**

• Now that the weather is improving, crews will soon begin the process of bringing in dirt to serve as the bottom layer of the new road. This activity should be complete in early May.



**Please Note:** We expect to close the third and final segment, Salem Canal Road to 11200 South, for construction in **early June**.

Work hours will typically be Monday through Friday, between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. Weekend work may take place on occasion if needed.

\*Schedule subject to change due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances.

#### **Traffic Alerts**

• Elk Ridge Drive is **CLOSED** between SR-198 and Salem Canal Road. 1700 West is the designated detour route.

### Safety

- Watch for construction vehicles entering and leaving the work zone. Do not follow construction vehicles into the work zone.
- The speed limit along the detour route on 1700 West is 25 mph. Please reduce speeds and use caution when taking the detour route.
