The removal 61 of the 75 foot rule will be impactful. Discussion ensued on the placement of structures and difficulty of 62 nuisance code. Tricia Thomas stated she does not think the city should throw out the 75-foot requirement 63 and does not think the city should change the code for 1 person. There are areas that butt up against the 64 livestock zones. Mayor Ellis stated that even if this amendment is passed the Rams will still need a 65 variance for landscaping.
