## 3. FOOD TRUCK DISCUSSION

Nelson Abbott stated the city code does not a mechanism allowing food trucks to operate in the city pursuant to state code. Elk Ridge does not have a commercial zone. Nelson contacted Libertas Institute to assist him in drafting code. Nelson feels this should be something the city needs to embrace for the residents Elk Ridge with some controls such as licensing, trash, parking . Tricia Thomas was concerned how the city would collect the tax. Royce Swensen stated food trucks report income from where the truck owner lives. Mayor Ellis stated he would like the city to embrace this and find a place for food trucks to park. Right now, Elk Ridge only has home business that operate within the home and there is not any available commercial property. Nelson Abbott will continue drafting the code and it will be on the next agenda for further discussion.

## 4. CAPITAL FACILITES PROJECT DISCUSSION

<u>Mayor Ellis</u> stated the city is in the process of updating the Capital Facilities Plan which will include updating impact fees and adding storm drain. Nelson stated the Capital Facilities Plan is a 5 year plan: he would like to be know if there is a way to be able have a yearly adjustment incase of a drastic increased or decrease in costs. Royce will talk to city Financial Director to see if and how that would be possible.
