A RESOLUTION ADOPTING RESOLUTION NO. 21-10-12-1R AMENDING THE STORM DRAINAGE ENTERPRISE FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING STORMWATER MANAGEMENT IMPROVEMENTS AND MAINTENANCE

WHEREAS, the city of Elk Ridge has a Storm Drainage enterprise fund for the purpose of funding stormwater management improvements and maintenance, and;

WHEREAS, the city of Elk Ridge is the recipient of \$256,525.00 from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) of 2021, and;

WHEREAS, the city of Elk Ridge anticipates an additional \$256,525.00 from the ARPA, and;

WHEREAS, the ARPA allows for monies received to be used for stormwater management, and;

WHEREAS, the city of Elk Ridge has an immediate and urgent need to provide stormwater management in the vicinity of Park Drive and Canyon View Rd., and;

WHEREAS, the city of Elk Ridge has applied for an additional \$475,000 of money from the Utah State Office of Planning and Budget COVID-19 Local Assistance Matching Grant Program, and;

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 Local Assistance Matching Grant application submitted by the city of Elk Ridge stated that the Storm Drainage enterprise fund would provide matching funds of \$300,000 for the purpose of stormwater management in the vicinity of Park Drive and Canyon View Rd.;

NOW, THEREFORE be it resolved that the Elk Ridge City Council will retain a minimum of \$300,000 in the Storm Drainage enterprise fund for the sole purpose of matching grant monies received from the COVID-19 Local Assistance Matching Grant submitted by the city of Elk Ridge until such a time that the exact match amount is known, and;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Elk Ridge City Council is committed to using 100 percent of ARPA monies received or to be received by the city in addition to all grant monies and required matching monies for the sole purpose of funding stormwater management improvements in the vicinity of Park Drive and Canyon View Rd.
