We recognize that you need to adopt the new voter participation areas on January 1, 2022. We are delayed in getting these created due to the timeframe the census data was completed as a result of COVID. We received final maps from the legislature less than two weeks ago. Currently we are working on the local school board boundaries and should have those completed by December 6. Our goal is to have the voting precincts completed by mid-December and the voter participation maps completed before the Christmas break.

Since most of you will only have one city council meeting in the month of December our recommendation would be to adopt a resolution with the voter participation areas as they stand with an understanding of adopting the new voter participation areas when they are created. Please work with your city attorney to decide what is best for your city. Feel free to reach out if you have any questions. Again, we apologize for the delay.
