**2. STORM WATER MITIGATION**

Mayor Haddock stated there was a meeting held onsite with the residents of Loafer Canyon with Councilmember Peterson, Councilmember Willis, Fire Chief Waite, and Engineer Mickelsen about the best course of action for flood control in the canyon. A 3 foot berm will in the area of the school turn around, jersey barriers will be placed at Park Dr and divert water to the east side of the road and close the intersection at Park Dr. and Loafer Canyon, there are more than 3000 sandbags available to residents. The field at the school property on Elk Ridge Dr. will be strengthened. Discussion ensued on liability to the city if someone working as a volunteer for the city is injured. Councilmember Thompson read the Utah State code which stated volunteers are treated as employees and are covered under the city's workman's comp insurance. Administration will look at the details of the city's workman's comp policy. The Cert program will be on an upcoming agenda.

Discussion ensued on lighting/dark sky. Discussion ensued on the new wildlife section. Councilmember Peterson will go through the entire code and update it.
