WORKSESSION 6:00 PM

Mayor Haddock stated the Capital Facilities plans are broken up between Parks, Transportation, Water, Sewer and Roads. Projects are identified in each of those categories and then the next phase is breaking those down into cost and the impact fees that are charged to new home builds. In order to do a project, it has to be in the capital facilities plan.

Transportation Plan - Mayor Haddock stated because the city is rated so high in the transportation plan, it is hard to put an impact fee to it. The city is rated good through 2043. Councilmember Willis stated the growth population numbers are different between different reports. The transportation map appendix is inconsistent with the language in the report and approved map of the city. The usage on the new section of Canyon View Dr. was done before the road was opened and is too low and needs to be redone. Councilmember Paxton asked if the city is looking at federal funds, if the city can get a project on the federal list and agreed to talk to Nancy about this. Councilmember Paxton stated there is \$45 million dollars in non-matching funds a year, allocated to trails but the projects have to be on the list. The old trails map is included but it is not addressed in the impact fees and Elk Ridge Dr. trails is not included at all. Councilmember Willis stated Table 14 line 2 is incorrect, it should be 11200 not Elk Ridge Dr. Update all the maps.

There are cement blocks blocking his gate. (These are temporary). He is also concerned with the rocks and thought the berm and rocks were going to be bigger and is concerned with motorcycles etc. going over it. Jan Christensen - stated her concern is the same area and wants to know what it is going to look like and what will happen with that area and doesn't want to lose their access.

Mayor Haddock stated there are a lot of details to work through as to whether that property will be surplused or other options.

Larry Lee- Scrub Oak is pushing the deer into the road as the scrub oak spreads. It also has very flammable resin which creates fire fuel. A trail needs to be made through the scrub oak as a fire break and the trees need to be trimmed along roadways to keep from pushing deer into the road. This will help the deer as well as residents by reducing fire fuel and keeping the deer off the roads.
