19	Mayor Haddock stated there isn't really a set agenda for the work session other than to get
20 21	together and discuss possible projects and goals for the city and how best to work together to get
22	things accomplished. Jerry Clark, Public Works Director, would like to get a dedicated line on
23	Elk Ridge Dr and road repairs done from the church up to Park Dr and the loop from Elk Ridge
24	Dr up to Gladstan connected, possibly a PRV He has met with some engineers to get this
25	drawn up. This is in the budget. He would also like to widen Canyon View up to Park Dr. Mayor
26	Haddock would like everyone to have 5 minutes. <u>Greg Shelton</u> wondered about the study on
27	PRV'S that was done, and did we do any and are there any PRV'S that are going to be done?
28	Mayor Haddock stated the water modeling is still being done, right now they aren't jiving. The
29	budget for next year is coming up and we will need to get Gladstan for sure in the budget.
30	Maureen Bushman stated her focus is on Parks and trails and completing the Master Plan. She
31	recommends putting parks in the Master Plan as well. She also recommends using Spencer Foster
32	as much as possible. She went through the General Plan and listed all the items stated in the plan
33	that will need to follow up on. Lisa Graham concurred with Maureen and her plan and asked
34	about the water lines that were in bad shape and if the city got that grant. Mayor Haddock stated
35	they city didn't get the grant that Bourgeois Owens sent, it was far more complicated then
36	presented and sent to the city 2 days before it was due. The water line issues have not changed.
37	Melanie Paxton stated she is working on the trails and the trail easement. Utah Recreation said
38	the city really just needs to talk to Payson. The goal for this year is to get mountain access.
39	Charles Wixom there are road projects happening this year. They are widening Elk Ridge Dr. as
40	much as possible, the dip above the roundabout will be fixed. The city needs to make sure there
41	are buffer zones in between projects so that all the roads aren't closed at the same time. Jared
42	Peterson stated Shuler Lane needs to be worked on and will be interested to see how the new
43	development code works out. Cory Thompson is working on working with SESD to see if there
44	is a way to continue to save money on power working with other cities to not duplicate work on
45	trucks etc. If everyone built transformers together is would be cheaper for everyone. <u>Tanya</u>
46	Willis' goal is to have the city website done by the end of summer, working on the park
47	development and city celebration.
