1. CIVIL SCIENCE PRESENTATION; GOOSENEST PARK PROJECT

Jeff Peay and Jordan Goff from Civil Science presented the different options per area for the proposed Goosenest Dr Park. They broke it down into different phases, the first phase being the base phase. There is an all-abilities playground, restroom, shade area, pavilion, water feature, mountain bike course, and parking. The different phases have options for the size and scope the different areas and the difference in costs. Councilmember Thompson suggested leaving the parking gravel for now instead of paving it. Councilmember Peterson recommended doing the entire water feature instead of phasing it in. Discussion ensued on the trail being natural instead of paved. Discussion ensued on ADA requirements for access, ground covering for play areas and fields such as alternatives to grass. Grants will be applied for for all phases, in order apply for grants the city needs the plans.
