




ROAD CLOSURE UPDATE

Elk Ridge Drive

On Monday, June 3, our crews will CLOSE the next segment of Elk Ridge Drive (Salem Canal Road to 11200 South). This means that Elk Ridge Drive will be FULLY CLOSED from SR-198 to 11200 South, including the intersection of Elk Ridge Drive and 10300 South, and the intersection of Elk Ridge Drive and Salem Canal Road. The suggested detour routes are 11200 South to Woodland Hills Drive

through Salem or Goosenest Drive to Salem Canal Road up into Payson (see map).

The closure between Salem Canal Road and 11200 South is expected to remain in place through late-

November. The northern segments (SR-198 to 10300 South, and 10300 South to Salem Canal Road) will be opened as they're

finished, which could tentatively be late-July and late-August, respectively.

Please reduce speeds and use caution when utilizing the detour routes, as there will be an influx of traffic in those areas while the closure is in place.

Work will typically take place between the hours of 7 a.m. and 7 p.m.

Construction schedules are subject to change. If there are significant changes in dates, email updates will be sent out.
