 Jim Chase welcomed at 7:00 PM. Opening remarks were said by Wayne Jones followed by the pledge of allegiance.

WAYNE JONES MOTIONED TO APPROVE THE AGENDA JARED BARTON SECONDED: VOTE YES - ALL (5), NO – (0)

PUBLIC HEARING AND ACTION

1. GENERAL PLAN

Shay Stark gave a brief overview of Elk Ridge and the changes and growth it has experienced. He pointed out the areas that are left to develop, which is the south end of the city. He went over the proposed changes to the General Plan since the Planning Commission had last seen it, that being the zoning change from Hillside Residential 1 to Critical Environment. Because of the change in the animal code it is proposed that RR 1 be changed to R&L 20,000 since they now have the same requirements. Change the annexation area on the corner of Elk Ridge Dr. and 11200 to commercial with a buffer and R-15,000 residential around it. The PUD was removed from the code last week. The R-12,000 is only for Bella Vista Dr. The additions to the are the trail and park on the south end have been placed on the map to connect the trail system to the Four Bay area and Loafer Canyon Road shows a possible future natural trail along the road.

Jim Chase opened the public hearing

 <u>David Cline</u> stated that he disagrees with the slopes being 20%. He pointed his property out on the map stating that it is. The areas to the south are steeper. He is concerned with the zoning/density change.

 Robert Strang stated that economically that if you restrict the lots to 5 or 2 1/2 acres it might and well be in the county. It really creates a feasibility issue bringing roads in and making the 2 access points. The zoning it has now combined with clustering will still create a good feel. He is concerned about the density change.

<u>Bob Paxton</u> stated that if you look at a monetary view the smaller lots will generate more revenue for the city. The 1 acre lot makes it more accessible for the average person, not just the wealthy. They purchased their property because the zone was based on a 1 acre lot and would like it to remain HR-1.

Jim Chase closed the public hearing.

Bruce Thorpe asked how long the HR-1 zone had been in place.

Shay Stark stated that it has been on place at least a decade

50	Max Staheli stated that it came into the city with the HR-1 zone. He gave a brief history of the
51	landowners.
52	Bruce Thorpe asked why there is an interest in changing the zone now.
53	Shay Stark stated the residents, the mayor, the city council want the mountainside to be
54	mountainside and not have it covered with homes. They want to have open space, and access to
55	trails and public lands.
56	Wavne Jones asked if there would be any negative impacts to the city with the 1 acre lots.

<u>Wavne Jones</u> asked if there would be any negative impacts to the city with the 1 acre lots.

Shay Stark stated in adding the cluster overlay zone directly into the code it would be beneficial to the city with road maintenance etc.

Jim Chase stated that he thought that the areas with the grades with 6-8% grades should stay in the HR-1 zone but the zone doesn't allow for clustering

Shay Stark stated that his proposal would be get rid of the overlays and add the option to cluster right into the code. This would safe a step and be an incentive to clustering

Bruce Thorpe stated that the sensitive area maps needs to be updated. There is a discrepancy with what the map says and the land owners say.

Shay Stark stated that the city would have to have the area surveyed in order to do that. The TOPO was done by Mountain Lands originally and do not have the data in order to change this.

Discussion ensued on the grades and the maps

Jim Chase asked if there were any comments from the Commission on annexation section.

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Jim Chase asked if there were any comments on the economics section

Jared Barton stated that he did not think that there should be an economics section since there is no commercial.

Bruce Thorpe stated that the first paragraph needed to be reworded slightly.

Jim Chase asked about the change in mix use developments being taken out of the general plan.

Shay Stark stated that the Mayor in his rewrite of the General Plan came to the conclusion that residential is used to keep the commercial spaces successful and there is no incentive to keep the commercial viable.

Discussion ensued on commercial being viable in Elk Ridge.

53 54 55	meeting. There was a question regarding roads that was not addressed. The transportation plan shows 2 roads going into the south end. In the event of fire or an emergency the city wanted 2 ways in and out of the south end, which is in the city code. Canyon View can possibly be realigned and

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extended to be a 3rd exit/entrance. Shay would like to show that on the map. The exact placement of the roads will be up to the developer but the General Plan needs to show the routes.

Discussion ensued on the differences between CE1, CE2, CE3 and HR1 and density. Reasons for changing the zoning is 1. What does the Planning Commission want the area to look like: density or open space? 2. Better use of roads and less infrastructure to maintain. There is no pressure in changing the zone but the mountainside is a clean slate. Does the city proceed with density like the rest of the city or try something different to preserve the mountainside?

Jim Chase stated that he would prefer to see the CE1 zone with 4 acre parcels; 1 lot per 4 acres or if clustered than 1 lot per acre. That gives the current HR1 landowners the option of 1 acre lots they currently have. Bruce Thorpe asked the landowners what they thought of the clustering. Robert Strang and Robert Paxton, landowners, like the clustering and thought it would work well with the infrastructure and the land. Nelson Abbott, City Council stated that density needed to be kept in mind because the Capital Facility Plan is based on X number of sewer connections, and the sewer connections were pre-negotiated with Payson. If the south becomes denser than was originally calculated, the city would run out of sewer connections.

Shay Stark stated that there will be legislative changes to the Moderate Income Housing so that section of the General Plan will be updated when those changes have been finalized by the Legislature.

PUBLIC HEARING - ACCESSORY APARTMENT CONDITIONAL USE

Bruce Thorpe opened the public hearing.

<u>Stan Nelson</u> state that he is the home owner. He presented a letter from a neighbor in support of the apartment. They have several properties where they have been able to be landlords and have been able to help people in that position. They plan to turn the walk out basement into an apartment. There are a couple issues that he would like to discuss.

<u>Neil Bushman</u> stated that he is concerned with the parking issue. The neighborhood is all single family houses and is concerned that bringing in apartments will cause the neighborhood to deteriorate and that there will be more cars than places to park.

Corby Murri stated that Neil just voiced his concerns.

Bruce Thorpe turned the time back over to Stan Nelson to go over the issues and questions.

Stan Nelson stated that the plan was to provide parking for the tenants with 2 parking spots: one on the right hand side of the driveway and one off street parking. They would take the garage and the left side of the driveway. The right side of the garage is a workshop. He also feels that the city code is too restrictive to lots of smaller sizes and asked how many accessory apartments exist.

Bruce Thorpe stated that he had no idea how many accessory apartments there are, although they just approved one a month ago.

<u>Jared Barton</u> stated that there are a lot of people that have accessory apartments. The problem is the on street parking during the winter when it is banned. That is the main concern.

Stan Nelson is in favor of good policy, snow removal makes sense. The 3 off street parking spaces required is excessive. If they would pave the area next to their driveway that would provide a third parking space but the ordinance states that it needs to be behind the front setback. He is not in favor of paving the cement pad across his side yard: it would be an eye sore. He feels that the parking requirement is unreasonable.

Bruce Thorpe is not aware of the city making an exception for parking requirements previously and asked if Stan had space with in the property to comply with the code.

<u>Stan Nelson</u> stated that he doesn't want to fill the street with cars but would be sure to put something in the contract with any tenants about parking on the street.

Bruce Thorpe closed the public hearing.

Wayne Jones stated that he does not have a problem with the apartment but the parking is a concern. He went to the property and watched the cars. If you park on Twilight, like he did, he had people pulling up behind him. After working in government for 30 years parking is problematic and the neighbors don't like it. He doesn't know how to solve the issue.

Jared Barton stated that the council knows his strong feelings about telling people what they can and cannot do with their own property. The planning commission would have to approve an exception to the 3 car parking rule. Either way it would require an extension of the pad, maybe not behind the front setback.

Stan Nelson stated that the revenue from the apartment would more than pay for the pad. He is more concerned with paving a significant amount of his grass to comply with city code. There is also a community mailbox on the side of his property on Twilight. It would not be safe to put a driveway right next to it.

Bruce Thorpe stated that the Planning Commission will not take action on this tonight. His gut reaction is there will not be much sympathy in making an exception in this regard. The code is there for a reason. It allows for accessory apartments and he would personally not a have a problem with an apartment if it weren't for the parking issue.

Stan Nelson requested a list of accessory apartments in the city. Royce Swensen stated that he would get something to Stan.

Jared Barton asked if this is proactive to deal with run off in the spring or is it retroactive to cover anything that has already happened as well. This needs to be passed for those who need it he was just wondering when the coverage started. Royce Swensen confirmed that this is retroactive. Darren Hinton asked if anyone in the city can use this for flooding or just Loafer Canyon. Jared Barton stated he understood it had was only for flooding due to the fire. Bruce Thorpe stated that if this doesn't cause the city any issues and it gives the residents who need it what they need then he doesn't see any problems. Darren Hinton is all for passing it but the city should be aware that the state may have the city do the mapping.
