LONGVIEW MEADOWS SUBDIVISION PRELIMINARY PLAT 26 27 Darren Hinton opened the public hearing 28 29 Tanya Willis stated she is concerned with the current plat and with the retention pond and the property 30 below it and if walls are needed the developer needs to put them in; in case the walls fail the developer should be responsible. She thinks the city should put in sidewalks on Hudson with the new road plan to 31 protect the children and that there should be a town hall meeting or another public hearing when the 32 revised plan comes out. She is concerned that the accessory building accessory apartment isn't thought 33 through enough and should make the accessory apartment in the home easier to certify and doesn't 34 understand parking not allowed in front of the home. 35 Mike Dubois is concerned about the design. His property borders the retention basin and would like 36 consideration from the city in not letting his land be landlocked. 37 Tom Pierce is concerned about the traffic of all the construction vehicles on Ama Fille Lane 38 Jan Christensen stated she is thankful this subdivision did not ask for changes to the zoning and wondered 39 how long the project will take. 40 Nathaniel Morrell is a teacher at the Salem Hills High School and invited all the students here tonight. His 41 home is the only house on Sunset. Is concerned about the gas line going through the property and is there a 42 road going down to Loafer Canyon. He is concerned about the traffic. When will the project begin and be 43 completed. What would be the price range of each of the lots. He will miss the empty fields and the view. 44 Ron Herbert is concerned about the bottle necks at 11200 and Elk Ridge needs another outlet down the 45 46 hill. Joe Wilkins, developer stated that all the issues that have been brought up are items that they are already 47 48 working on with the engineers and are modifying the intersection at Canyon View Dr. There is a lot of thought and a lot of professionals working on the development. 49 50 51 Darren Hinton closed the public hearing for Longview Meadows.
