the current maps and should still have the files. The Call-to-Action section has been renamed to Strategies. The 53 54 Annexation maps and Future Land Use maps were combined. One strategy is to review the General Plan annually for any updates in June or July to coincide with state legislative changes that occur May 1. Elk Ridge 55 being part of the Wildland Urban Interface inserted into the introductory section. The term "bedroom 56 community" will be changed to "X Urban". All demographic numbers will be changed to be consistent. 57 Horrocks Engineering will review the General Plan with their professional editors to make sure everything is 58 grammatically correct and a graphics team that will polish it up. The Economic Element section will be 59 removed because the city does not have any commercial and it is not required to be in the General Plan. The 60 transportation map designation of streets such as local streets being changed to minor arterials that are not at this 61 time being used as a minor collector will remain labeled as local streets. Future roads will be labeled future roads 62 and will be determined through development. The term divided trail on the trails map needs to be defined and 63 future trails be labeled as future trail instead of possible trail. Andrew Jackson stated cities under 5,000 are not 64 required to implement a moderate-income housing plan. Population is taken from the most recent census and the 65 last official census has Elk Ridge population under 5000 so the city is not required to do moderate income 66 housing at this time but should move in that direction shortly. Some cities are using the accessory apartments as 67 part of their moderate-income housing plan and offering amnesty to illegal accessory apartments to get them 68 registered so they can be counted. The homeowners are not penalized and fined but can bring them up to code. 69 70 Self-help housing and accessory apartments that have family members living in them count towards moderate income housing. Apartments would have to rent around \$800 less than Provo which could be difficult in Elk 71 Ridge, but the city would just have to show "reasonableness" in the rent to qualify. All the changes will be made, 72 and the final draft will be presented at the March planning commission meeting and the public hearing will be in 73 April. 74 75 4.
